Justice for Terrol Massey and Black Youths In State Judicial Systems

Dear US Attorney General, Eric Holder, US Department of Justice, Washington, DC...

As an US citizen, I demand that you, the first Black US Attorney General “man-up” to be the Justice Champion that all American citizens hoped would be found in yourself, and the first African American President, the Hon. Barack Hussein Obama.

Individuals within State judicial systems, such as New York, practice Jim Crow-like policies against West African Black US citizens, i.e. the Emancipated Slave Class. Blacks are a mere 12-13% of the general population, yet, they comprise disproportioned numbers of youths incarcerated in the State judicial systems. This is radical injustice!

This Black experience is exemplified by the case of Terrol Massey of Amherst, New York who is “locked-up” due to unjust and biased judicial procedures of the Empire State. Terrol, like thousands of other Black youths is a victim of anti-American policies that denies them full “equal justice under the Law...as is enjoyed by White citizens” according to the Constitutional Mandates of the 14th Amendment and the Civil Rights Act of 1866.
